Entry Info:

- Squad Size on the Day: Minimum-7, Maximum –12
- o Each borough is permitted two substitutions per gender, as long as the maximum squad
- o size on the day is not exceeded.
- o U14's.

Competition Format:

- o AM session, teams will play a round robin across 4 groups.
- The top 2 teams in each group and, the best 2 placed 3 teams (10 teams_ will progress to the Trophy Competition in the afternoon.
- The teams not qualified for the trophy final will progress to the plate knockout finals in the afternoon.
- o Matches will be played across the Olympic Pitch and pitch 2 at Lee Valley.

Eligibility:

 Any U14 or younger player who represents at County, London Area or representative squads above this level are not eligible to play in the London Youth Games.
