Substitutions: Boroughs will be allocated 2 spare chip numbers for substitutions.
Additional/late entries will not be accepted. Substitutions must be in the same age and gender as the original entry they are replacing. All substitution details must be given to an LYG member of staff at registration to ensure chip timers are activated.

#### Kit & Equipment:

- o Swim hats and swim goggles must be worn during the swim and worn or carrier to transition.
