Competition Day Information

- Squad Size: Each borough is permitted to bring a minimum of 1 rider and a maximum of 40 riders on the day. Each borough is only permitted a maximum of 20 novice and 20 expert riders alongside any additional non-scoring Wingz riders.
- Substitutions: Each borough is permitted two substitutions, so long as the maximum squad size on the day is not exceeded. The substitutions must be in the same event/age category and gender category as the original entry and all substitutions details must be provided at registration.

Kit & Equipment:

All competitors must provide their own equipment. Competitors must wear protective clothing whilst on the track, including a full-face helmet, gloves, long-sleeves top and bottoms (no shorts, tear resistant fabric advisable). Only 20" BMX or cruiser bokes are allowed, and stunt pegs must be removed. Front brakes must also be removed from the bike. Handlebar grips are mandatory and must completely cover the ends of the handlebars. Handlebar ends must be plugged, tape will not be deemed sufficient.

Results:

A QR code will be available to view the results.

- Post event results will be available to download on the competition webpage within 48 hours of the competition ending. see the games rules rule 23.1 for further information on disputes.
- Queries on individual results can be raised in writing up to 24 hours after results have been published.
- In the event of a competition appeal, the use of external video footage and/or photographs <u>will not</u> be accepted in any circumstances.
