 - **Sprint Squad Size:** Minimum of 1 and maximum of 10 competitors (one competitor per age category and gender) plus any non-scoring para-paddlers
 - **Slalom Squad Size:** Minimum of 1 competitor per race, per gender. Maximum of 4 competitors.
 - **Substitutions:** Each borough is permitted two substitutions per gender, so long as the maximum squad size on the day is not exceeded.

- **Kit & Equipment:** Kayaks will be provided. Buoyancy aids and safety helmets must always be worn by competitors whilst on the water. There will be a small selection of buoyancy aids, helmets and paddles available, however we encourage competitors to bring their own.

Results:

- Queries on individual results can be raised in writing up to 24 hours after results have been published.
