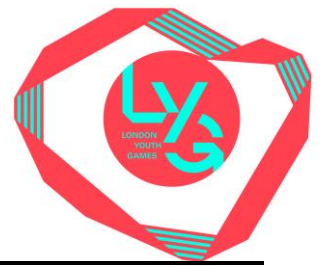

 - **Competitive and Participation Squads Size:** Minimum 1, maximum 12 per gender per competition
 - **Substitutions:** Only named reserves can be used to directly replace withdrawn swimmers. This must be declared to LYG member of staff at registration. No other swimmers may be used as substitutes.
 - **Kit & Equipment:** Competitors must wear a swimming costume, goggles and provide their own towel. Swimming caps are encouraged.
