 - Squad Size: Minimum – 4 (2M+2F) • Maximum – 8 (4M+4F)

Competition Format: Juniors and Seniors will compete as ONE borough team. Each match consists of 4 rubbers (each played by a different player).

- 1 Junior Female Singles
- 1 Junior Male Singles
- 1 Senior Female Singles
- 1 Senior Male Singles

If boroughs tie at 2 rubbers-all in a match, then a tie break shoot out shall be played to decide the match winner. This will consist of 1 Mixed Doubles.

Eligibility:

- Junior players must have a World Tennis Number between 25-40.9 or no World Tennis Number to be eligible for this competition.
- Senior players must have a World Tennis Number between 20-40.9 or no World Tennis Number to be eligible for this competition.

Results:

- Post event - results will be available to download on the competition webpage within 48 hours of the competition ending. see the [games rules](#) rule 23.1 for further information on disputes.
- Queries on individual results can be raised in writing up to 24 hours after results have been published.
- 2 Teams from each qualifying session (a total of 8 teams) will progress to the Finals at Lee Valley Hockey and Tennis Centre on Sunday 30th June 2024. Separate information will be sent to the qualifying teams.
- **In the event of a competition appeal, the use of external video footage and/or photographs will not be accepted in any circumstances.**

Tubes and Trains: Closest station is Fairlop (Central line) which is right next to the venue.

Buses: 462 (use Fairlop Station stop)

Parking:

All vehicles must pay if using the car park at Redbridge Sports Centre: Up to 3 hours £1.30; up to 6 hours £2.60; up to 9 hours £8 and all day is £15 on weekdays. Failure to do so will result in a parking fine being issued that neither LYG nor the Venue will be held responsible for.

For coaches and minibuses that wish to park - Please use the overflow car park. You can access this by driving through the first car park you come to. Please note there is limited space, and it will be on a first-come-first served basis.

Payment for parking can be made through app, phone or at reception via a tablet using a debit/credit card.

Any coaches wanting to drop off it is recommended you do this in the main centre car park which is the first car park you come to, to avoid getting caught in any congestion by driving up to the overflow car park.

Drop off: Free drop off up to 20 minutes. You will be fined if you stay any longer, so please make sure to pay if you do.
