 - Squad Size: Each borough is permitted to bring a minimum of 7 and a maximum of 12 players on the day.
 - **Substitutions:** Each borough is permitted two substitutions per competition, so long as the maximum squad size on the day is not exceeded. Any additions or late entries after the entry deadline has passed will not be accepted. All substitution details must be provided at registration on the day of the event.
- **Kit & Equipment:** All participants must wear shin pads and remove any jewellery worn. Moulded boots, trainers or astro boots are the only permitted footwear. Players without the correct footwear will not be permitted to play.
- **Surface:** All matches will be played on 3G pitches with dimensions of approximately 40x60 yards with the penalty spot at 8 yards.
