
If selected, you will attend multiple fun, engaging and developmental sessions in inspirational venues (see below) with a mixture of in person and online events. Events will include exclusive experiences, inspirational speakers, interactive workshops and sessions to have your input on the future of LYG. In the past cohorts, the LYG33 group have had visited Wembley Stadium, Twickenham, Wimbledon, BBC Sport Studios, met professional athletes, delivered speeches at LYG events and participated in exciting projects.

LYG33 Team Members who successfully complete the season, will be awarded the LYG Bronze Award in Youth Engagement & Leadership in Sport, accredited by recognised body Associated Sports Qualifications (ASQ).




Please note all Senior Leadership Team, and Leadership Team roles have now been filled. We are accepting applications for Team Members to represent their borough.


